HOUSE RULES

To ensure a comfortable, safe, "no surprise" stay please read the following information!

- Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the cabin.
- Children must be accompanied in the hot tub at all times.
- Do not flush wipes, paper towels, feminine products, or anything other than small amounts of toilet paper. This property is on a septic system and improper items can cause serious plumbing issues.
- Do not wash food waste or dispose of grease in the sinks to protect the septic system.
- No parties or large gatherings. Please alert Marisa if you plan to have non-registered guests visit the property.
- Fireworks and firearms are strictly prohibited on the premises at all times, including during July 4th celebrations. This is to ensure the safety and tranquility of all guests.

After every visit we carefully review the property. Any damaged, broken or missing items will be charged to your credit card. Please respect our home and property by taking care of it.

CHECK OUT PROCEDURE

Failure to comply with the check-out procedures and expectations can result in added cleaning fees. At the conclusion of your stay please complete the following items:

- Report any accidental or intentional/reckless damages.
- Check thoroughly for all personal items. If you leave any personal items behind after checkout, you will need to arrange pickup through a carrier of your choice. We are unable to deliver or ship forgotten items on your behalf.
- Leave the house in the same condition as you found it.
- If you have moved any furniture, please put it back. Place all used towels in the bathroom.
- ***DO NOT REMOVE BEDDING FROM BEDS.***
- Wash and put away all used dishes. Take all food and drinks with you.
- Turn off all lights
- Shut all windows.
- Pick up any cigarette butts and other trash from outside.
- Bag your trash and dispose of it in the dumpster, located at the end of the driveway.
- Lock the door.

OTHER DETAILS

GRILL

Gas grill and 1 tank of propane are provided. Please turn off the gas valve when not in use to prevent gas leaks and ensure safety

LOCKS

The front door has a digital deadbolt. Use your code to unlock the front door from the outside.

FIREPIT

Firewood is available to the left of the house, or to the right of the fireplace if prepaid. A fire starter basket with lighters and marshmallow sticks is located to the left of the fireplace. Firewood can be ordered for \$35/quarter rick plus tax \$39.90 in advance or by sending Venmo. Firewood is stacked near the firepit area for your convenience. You can also provide your own firewood. No unattended fires and fire must stay within the fire pit.

Please watch children closely around the fire.

FLASHLIGHT

The flashlights are located on the kitchen counter. Kindly return them for the next guests.

FIRST AID KIT & FIRE EXTINGUISHER

The fire extinguisher can be found under the kitchen sink, while the first aid kit is conveniently located in the bathroom.



COFFEE MAKER

The kitchen is equipped with a Keurig K-Duo Single Serve K-Cup Pod & Carafe Coffee Maker.

HOT TUB BREAKER

The hot tub breaker is located on the wall to the left of the hot tub. A picture is available for reference in case you need to reset it.

PACK 'N PLAY

A Pack 'n Play is available and can be found in the left corner of the bedroom, near the nightstand.

EXTRA SUPPLIES

Paper towels and trash bags are kept under the sink. Batteries can be found in the junk drawer to the left of the sink.

TOWELS

Please do not use solid-colored towels for the hot tub. Hot tub towels are provided.

SWITCHES


The porch light stays on at all times. The switch is covered (a video is available for reference).

OTHER DETAILS



HOT TUB RULES

- The tub is to be used responsibly and is not to be used as a substitute wading pool by children. Allowing children to jump or dive into the water is not permitted under any circumstances. Children must not use the spa unsupervised at any time. No infants or toddlers in the spa.
- Please shower before using the tub to remove make-up, sunscreen, insect repellent or any other oil-based products.
- Only clean swimwear may be worn in the tub as the chemicals in the water will remove the colored dyes found in ordinary clothing, causing them to leach into the water and turn it cloudy.
- Prevent accidental drowning. Leave the hot tub cover on when the spa is unsupervised and/or not being used.
- Prevent Hyperthermia. Understand that alcohol and other medications greatly increase the chance of hyperthermia – the opposite of hypothermia. This occurs when the internal body temperature reaches several degrees above the normal temperature of 98.6 degrees.
- NO GLASS or food in or around the spa.
- Capacity is defined for 6 people.
- Do not attempt to access any of the controls other than the temperature and jet controls.
- Do not use a hot tub if you are taking any medication that makes you drowsy or affects your circulation; if necessary, check with your doctor. Pregnant women and the elderly should also consult their doctor before using a hot tub.
- Do not use the hot tub if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs as your judgment will be impaired and you could become unconscious and drown.
- No smoking is permitted in or around the tub.
- People with cuts or external infections should not use the tub.
- Shoulder length hair or longer should be restrained as it can get caught in the drainpipes and cause harm or drowning.



HOT TUB INSTRUCTIONS

To unlock your Jacuzzi J-210 from Lock Mode (L1 or L2):

1. Enter Mode Selection:

- Press and hold the WARMER (+) and COOLER (-) buttons simultaneously until the display changes.

2. Cycle Through Modes:

- While holding the buttons, use them to toggle between Lock Modes (L1 or L2) and other modes.
- Select the desired mode (e.g., standard or economy mode) to unlock the system.

3. Confirm Unlock:

- Release the buttons once the display confirms the mode change.

AFTER USING THE HOT TUB

Please always cover the hot tub when not in use to help maintain water temperature and cleanliness. Make sure the cover is securely snapped down to prevent children, pets, or wildlife from accessing the hot tub.

JACUZZI TUB HOT WATER INSTRUCTIONS

This home has two 50-gallon water heaters, providing a total of 100 gallons of hot water.

- **Important:** If you fill the whirlpool tub using only hot water, it will drain both tanks. Recovery time for the heaters is approximately 1 hour.
- **Plan accordingly** when using hot water for showers, dishes, or other needs before or after filling the tub.
